Councilman Dylan Hedrick

A few weekends ago, I had the pleasure of taking a tour of the Holford Recreation Center as I joined the Parks and Recreation Board on their tour of various parks facilities. The steel frame of the building structure was in place; and one was able to get a real sense of what the building will look like when finished.

The first thing you notice when walking up to the building is how the structure rises above the park offering great views of the surrounding fields and future pool from the second story balcony and patio. The weightroom, meeting room, and recreation room will all be much larger than the previous spaces in the center, and the gym will feature two full basketball courts with an indoor walking track on the second story overlooking the gym.

We also were able to view the formwork of the pool starting to take shape. The lazy river, lap pool and children's play area were all visible with the staff offices/party rental area and the restroom/changing rooms already roofed in. Later this month, Council will have an all-day Saturday meeting to kick off our budgeting season. The City Manager will begin our discussions by laying out his budget priorities. This year, the focus will be on discussing the results of our streets assessment survey, restoring a cost of living adjustment to city retirees, and preparing for another bond election next May.

We will also look to hire additional city staff as required to operate our new and larger facilities such as Holford Recreation Center and the West Garland Branch Library that are scheduled to open next year. I welcome any input you have regarding our budget spending and what your priorities are next year for our municipal budget.

Make plans to join us at our annual Fourth of July celebration named "Red, White and You" which returns to the Downtown Square Wednesday, July 3, after being at Firewheel Town Center for the past few years. The festivities start at 5:00 PM with the presentation of the colors followed by live music from Texas singersongwriters Jon Stork at 5:30 PM and Randall King at 8:00 PM.

Pony rides, carnival games and a bomb pop popsicle station are available for the kids along with food trucks, a hat bar, and apple pie eating contest. The festivities will conclude with a drone light show at 9:30 PM. If you were Downtown for the LeAnn Rimes concert which opened the Square, this drone show promises to be much larger and even more impressive! I'll see you Downtown!



About Oakridge Neighborhood Association (ONA):



The ONA has no authority over and takes no position over private property matters. The Fiscal Year begins June 1 and ends May 31st of the following year. Membership is voluntary. Oakridge Districts/Directors:

Oakridge is comprised of 1166 homes divided up into "Districts" by Street. Each District is represented by an ONA District Director. Click *Find Your District* to locate your District and ONA District Director.

Oakridge Perimeter Walls:

ONA Membership dues provide for the maintenance, landscaping, and mowing "around" the perimeter walls. If your home is on the outer perimeter, you will be responsible for the repair or replacement of damaged walls on your property. Sidewalk Repairs-City Cost Share Program:

Per Garland's City Ordinance, if you own property in Garland, it is your responsibility to keep sidewalks, parkways, curbs, and driveways adjacent to your property in a good and safe condition and free from any defects and hazards. A property owner who qualifies in all three categories may now bear as little as 10 percent of the cost of fixing their sidewalk.
